With Deepest Sympathy...

The 35th President of the Evansville IMA Chapter, Robert E. Hampel, passed away on March 18, 2007 in Naples, Florida.

Bob joined the IMA, formerly National Association of Accountants, on July 1, 1965 in Cincinnati. In January 1968, he became the assistant controller of Keller-Crescent Co. and joined the Evansville Chapter. He joined the Evansville Board as Director of Communication for 1968/1969 followed by Director of Publicity, Programs, Special Activities, Member Relations and Community Affairs. For Chapter year 1976/1977, Bob was elected Vice President of Membership followed by Vice President of Education, Communications and Administration before being elected Chapter President for 1980/1981.

After his year as Chapter President, Bob served on the National Research Committee for three years and served two years as a National Director. In 1984, Bob was inducted into the Stuart Cameron McCleod Society at the NAA Conference in Seattle. Bob received a Certificate of Merit for a manuscript which appeared in the July 1977 Issue of Management Accounting.

Bob retired in 2002 as CFO and Senior Executive Vice President. He was instrumental in the management buyout of the company and remained on the Board of Directors after his retirement.

The members of the Evansville Chapter extend their sympathy to Bob's wife Nancy and family.
